Pursuant to the Class Action Fairness Act of 2005 (“CAFA”), 28 U.S.C. § 1715, I write on behalf of defendants in the above-captioned case to inform you of a proposed class action settlement.

- A copy of the Complaint in the above-captioned action, which was filed on June 6, 2014 (D.I. 1);
- A copy of Plaintiff’s Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of Proposed Settlement (D.I. 53), Memorandum of Law in Support of Plaintiff’s Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of Proposed Settlement (D.I. 54), and Declaration of Melinda R. Coolidge in Support of Plaintiff’s Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of Proposed Settlement (D.I. 55) (the “Coolidge Declaration”) with exhibits thereto, all of which were filed on February 16, 2017.
