**DECLARATION OF ROSANNA K. MCCALIPS REGARDING NOTICE OF
PROPOSED SETTLEMENT PURSUANT TO 28 U.S.C. § 1715**

I, Rosanna K. McCalips, declare and state as follows:

1. I am a partner at Jones Day, counsel for Defendant Kyorin Pharmaceutical Co., Ltd. in the above-captioned action. I am a member in good standing of the bar of the District of Columbia. I am admitted *pro hac vice* in this matter. I submit this declaration upon personal knowledge to demonstrate Defendants' compliance with the notice requirements of the Class Action Fairness Act of 2005, 28 U.S.C. § 1715 ("CAFA").

2. On February 16, 2018, Plaintiff Hartig Drug Company, Inc. filed its Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of Proposed Settlement (D.I. 53).

3. On February 27, 2018, this Court entered an Order Granting Preliminary Approval of Class Settlement (D.I. 56) approving the proposed class action settlement between Plaintiff and Defendants in the above-captioned action.

4. On March 2, 2018, staff of Jones Day, acting under my direction and supervision and on behalf of all Defendants, served the CAFA Notice, which consisted of a cover letter and certain accompanying documents enumerated in the letter, upon the Attorney General for the United States of


America and the Attorney General or appropriate government official in each state or territory in which a class member resides via Certified Mail.

5. Attached hereto as Exhibit 1 is a true and correct copy of the cover letter described in paragraph 4, which includes a list of the names and addresses of the government officials upon whom the CAFA Notice was served.

6. Defendants' counsel has received no objection in response to the CAFA notices and has not been notified by the United States Postal Service that any of the CAFA notices could not be delivered.
